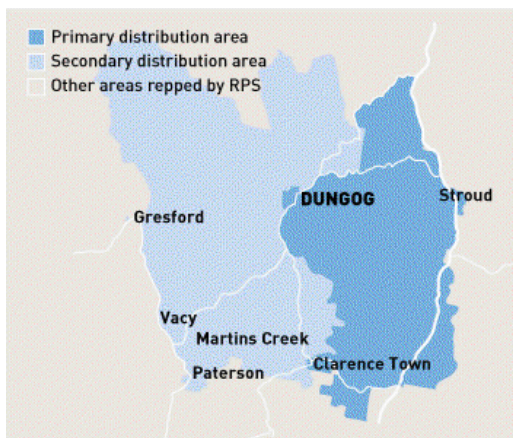

The Market

Dungog was first settled in the 1820s and is the focus of a diversity of economic activities including agriculture and industry. Its long history is reflected in the many historic buildings built in the mid-1800s, using local bricks and cedar. Dungog, and sister towns of Clarence Town, Gresford/East Gresford and Paterson, are the "Gateway to the Forests" - the forests of the Barringtons. The Barrington Tops boast a vast untamed area of State Forests, National Parks and Wilderness. The Dungog district is located on the rich alluvial flats of the Williams and the Paterson Rivers, two of the clean mountain streams emanating from the southern falls of the Barringtons. The area is only 45 minutes from the sub-regional centres of Raymond Terrace and Maitland, with easy access to the major Newcastle and Sydney regions.
